EXECUTIVE NEWS At the January meeting in addition to some discussion about various administrative matters and ways in which procedures could be streamlined to make life easier, two significant decisions were made

- In future the time between the closing date for entries and the event itself should where possible be shortened. Also late entries will be accepted at the discretion of the organisers, but only in Class O. This is a concession which will allow members - particularly new ones - at least an opportunity to enjoy the trial even though they were unable to enter at the appropriate time.
- Entry forms and regulations should immediately be available as a down load from the MCC website, with the intention that soon these would be Emailed to all members with electronic addresses thus saving the club considerable printing costs at a time when event promotional costs are rising.

FILM OF THE 2006 EXETER TRIAL.

Bill Lankester of J.K.M. Video Films, had cameras at Tillerton Steep, Fingle, Penhales Plantation and Simms. Nearly every vehicle that attempted the last two of these sections is recorded upon film. The finished recordings are 4 hours of cars or 1.5 hours of bikes representing probably the most comprehensive record ever of what happened upon the day and have sound though no voiced commentary. Whatever your preferred mount the viewing of both films is recommended. The various styles of achieving success is as diverse as the individual competitors so if you ever thought it would be better to use another machine take the chance of viewing just how easy (or not) someone else finds it.
