The Land's End Classic Road Trial 19th/20th April 2019

This event has evolved out of Class R in our main trial into a competitive event that stays on asphalt apart from 2 timed tests on private well-surfaced ground.

Any vehicle can enter apart from 4WD or commercials (at the Clerk of the Course's discretion) but must be road legal.

The only extra items that need to be carried are a spill kit and a 1.75 litre fire extinguisher in cars or threewheelers. Motorcycles and cars are welcomed.

There is no need for special tyres or a towrope nor for a rally-style trip meter. It will run at the same time and over much of the same route as our famous Land's End Trial. A comprehensive route book is provided in advance. Typically, you will start at one minute intervals at one of the main trial starts at 7.30pm on Good Friday.

You will converge with other competitors at Bridgwater in Somerset later that evening. After scrutineering and an hour's rest halt, you will set off with the idea of keeping to scheduled time throughout the official route. The route is not marked on the road, but is easily followed via the route book.

The average speed needed is variable but overall is about 20mph. You must be no minutes early and no more than 10 minutes late at any of the 8 time controls to qualify for a First Class award. In addition, there are seven observed sections on tarmac where you may be required to stop and restart at certain points. There are also 7 route boards to find and note down. These too must be correctly carried out to win that coveted first class award. There are 2 further rest halts en route with a total mileage of over 370 miles.

You will finish in Hayle, Cornwall about 3pm on Easter Saturday.

This is a new event that will grow in popularity by providing a challenge to a sporting competitor in a reliable vehicle at a reasonable price.
