24TH to 26TH JUNE 2022

ADDITIONAL SUPPLEMENTARY REGULATIONS

Governed by the General Regulations of Motorsport UK., incorporating the provisions of the sporting code of the F.I.A. and The National Sporting Code of the A.C.U. these special event regulations and the current M.C.C. Standing Supplementary Regulations as amended by any written instructions that may be issued for the event. ELIGIBILITY: The Main Trial, Class O and the Classic Road Trial are open to full and family members of the M.C.C. An invitation is also open to the Police and Army Motorcycling Assns. riding motorcycles, the Vintage Sports Car Club, the Vintage Motorcycle Club, the Morgan Sports Car Club, The Frazer Nash Car Club, Crash Box & Classic Car Club, the Trail Riders Fellowship and the MGCC (SW Centre). All ACTC affiliated club members are also invited.

M.C.C. members must pay their 2022 subscription before the event. All entrants must declare, at on-line entry, that they will have a valid M.O.T. certificate for their vehicle, if applicable, at the start of the trial. Classes running in this event will be as per the M.C.C. SSRs. A letter of consent from a parent or guardian is required for car passengers under the age of 16; competitors whose passengers are under 16 should contact the Secretary of the Trial but, in the meantime, not delay their entry.

ROUTE: Mileage approximately 500 (main trial and class O) & 600 (road trial). The route and Observed Sections will be predominantly on public roads. **Competitors in all classes** will be issued with a comprehensive Route Book in electronic Word and pdf format before the event. The contents and instructions of the Route Book and final instructions must be considered as part of these regulations, together with any amendments issued at the Trial Start.

INSURANCE: It is the individual competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are properly insured as required by the Road Traffic Act for the public road sections of the event. The club have arranged insurance through REIS to enable car competitors whose everyday policy excludes trials, competition etc. to comply with the Road Traffic Act for the public road sections of the event. The premium for those car entrants wishing to take up the REIS cover for the trial is **£67.20** for ALL car classes. Competitors who are able to comply with all of the following: over 19 and held a full licence for at least 6 months, not more than 1 fault accident in last 3 years, had no convictions other than a Maximum of 6 Points on their licence and must be medically fit to drive, will be accepted automatically. If you are unable to comply with any of these points, you will require a Letter of Acceptance from REIS; contact the Trial Secretary straight away to arrange this. If you have not received your Letter of Acceptance prior to the date of the event, you will not have cover. This does not affect the M/Cycle entry as the ACU, to which all riders must belong, already provides RTA cover for their members on trials.

STARTS AND FINISH; Day 1: Nailsworth to Exeter. Day 2 Start and Finish Exeter. Day 3 Start Exeter, Finish Nailsworth

Standard starting time is 7.00a.m. Friday 24th June 2022. Competitors and passengers must sign

ALL SIGNATURE SHEETS at least 30 minutes before their own starting time.

PETROL: Availability of petrol will be noted in the Route Book. (Spare petrol must be carried in approved containers, firmly secured to your vehicle.)

AWARDS will be as per current M.C.C. SSRs.

ENTRIES: Open on the 1st November 2021 and close on 25th May 2022, or earlier if the maximum number of 180 entries is received.

Entry Fees: Motorcycle & Car Classes (including A.C.U. Premier Cover for Motorcyclists)

Trial	£200
Team Entry Fee per team	£22.50

Entry Fees may not be returnable after closing date unless the event is cancelled, in which case 15% will be retained for administration charges.

Split Driving/Riding:

In cars, the driver and passenger will be allowed to swap roles at Launceston, so the entrant must drive the first half of the event, the passenger the second. To allow this, both must have suitable membership (not passenger membership), and be suitably insured. The following rules officially allow this to happen:

MCC SSRs 6.1 Para 1 Sentence 1 does not apply.

For Outfits and 3 Wheelers, the ACU have allowed us to run under a 'Special' permit, also allowing the Entrant and passenger to swap at Launceston. The following rules officially allow this to happen:

MCC SSRs 6.1 Para 1 Sentence 1 does not apply.

To split the driving, the question relating to split driving on the entry form must be ticked, so the MCC know who is driving at which point on the event.

Medal awards will be given for the performance of the vehicle on the whole event, so the scores of the entrant and passenger will be added together as if it was one driver/rider throughout.
