

Exeter Trial Entry Form – January 5th and 6th 2024

1. I wish to enter the 2024 Exeter Trial and declare that the particulars given on this form are correct in every respect.
2. Held under the General Regulations of MSUK (incorporating the provisions of the International Sporting Code of the FIA) and or the National Sporting Code of the Auto Cycle Union, the Standing Regulations, Supplementary Regulations and the Final Instructions.

2.1 Motorsport UK DECLARATION 'I declare that I have been given the opportunity to read the General Regulations of the Motorsport UK and, if any, the Supplementary Regulations for this event and agree to be bound by them. I declare that I am physically and mentally fit to take part in the event and I am competent to do so. I acknowledge that I understand the nature and type of the competition and the potential risk inherent with motor sport and agree to accept that risk. I understand that motorsport can be dangerous and accidents causing death, injury, disability and property damage can and do happen. I understand that these risks may give rise to my suffering personal injury or other loss and I acknowledge and accept these risks. In consideration of the acceptance of this entry I agree that neither any one of or any combination of Motorsport UK and its associated clubs, the organisers, the track owners or other occupiers, the promoters and their respective officers, servants, representatives and agents (the "Parties") shall have any liability for loss or damage which may be sustained or incurred by me as a result of participation in the Event including but not limited to damage to property, economic loss, consequential loss or financial loss howsoever caused. Nothing in this clause is intended to or shall be deemed to exclude or limit liability for death or personal injury. To the fullest extent permitted by law I agree to indemnify and hold harmless each of the Parties in respect of any loss or damage whatsoever and howsoever arising from my participation in this event. I declare that to the best of my belief the driver(s) possess(es) the standard of competence necessary for an event of the type to which this entry relates and that the vehicle entered is suitable and roadworthy for the event having regard to the course and the speeds which will be reached'. I declare that the use of the vehicle hereby entered will be covered by insurance as required by the law which is valid for such part of this event as shall take place on roads as defined by the law. I declare that the vehicle entered is registered, taxed, has a valid MOT certificate (where appropriate) and is roadworthy as required by law.' If I am the Parent or Guardian of the driver 'I understand that I shall have the right to be present during any procedure being carried out under the Supplementary Regulations issued for this event and the General Regulations of Motorsport UK.' As the Parent/Guardian 'I confirm that I have acquainted myself and the minor with Motorsport UK General Regulations, agree to pay any appropriate charges and fees pursuant to those Regulations (to include any appendices thereto) and hereby agree to be bound by those Regulations and submit myself without reserve to the consequences resulting from those Regulations (and any subsequent alteration thereof). Further, I agree to pay as liquidated damages any fines imposed upon me up to the maxima set out in Part 3, Appendix 1.'

Where the Parent is not present there must be a Guardian who must produce a written and signed authorisation from the Parent/Guardian to act as their representative.

2.2 ACU ENTRY DECLARATION: In consideration of being permitted to participate in this event I declare that I will be bound by the declaration on the event entry form. I also acknowledge and accept the Risks of Motorsport as shown on the said entry form. I have read and understood **The Auto Cycle Union Ltd Data Protection Policy** and I consent to the collection and retention of my personal information by the ACU. I give permission for details of any injuries I may suffer during this event to be given to the Clerk of the Course. I/we confirm that I/we are eligible to compete on the machines for which I/we have entered. I/we confirm that I/we are not suspended or my/our ACU Licence has not been suspended/withdrawn from any ACU competition. I confirm that I am physically and mentally able to participate and am competent to do so. I confirm that I am not currently suspended from ACU permitted competition or on the ACU Stop List as a result of incurring a Concussion injury. I declare that I have not tested positive or been required to self-isolate as a result of having had symptoms related to Covid-19 or been in contact with someone who has been infected with the virus in the last ten day period leading up to this event.

2.3 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT OF THE RISKS OF MOTORSPORT: I understand that by taking part in this event I am exposed to a risk of death, becoming permanently disabled or suffering some other serious injury and I acknowledge that even in the event that negligence on the part of the ACU, any event organiser, any circuit owner, the promoter, the organising club, the venue owner, or any individual carrying out duties on their behalf were to be a contributory cause of any serious injury I may suffer, the dominant cause of any serious injury will always be my voluntary decision to take part in a high risk activity.

I have read the above and acknowledge that my participation in motorsport is entirely at my own risk. I agree that I am required to register on arrival by "signing on" at the designated place before taking part in the event.

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Insurance: Motor Cycles

Vehicles and motorcycles must have a valid motor insurance policy which provides as a minimum, Third Party Liability cover that complies with the Road Traffic Act. This can be either, by extending an existing motor policy to cover the event, or, by purchasing additional cover, providing under the Event Road Section Scheme as an adjunct to an existing motor policy. If a competitor has an extension to their existing policy, they will be required to sign a declaration that the cover complies with the requirements of the Road Traffic Act. Any responsibility for a fraudulent or misleading declaration about existing cover lies with the competitor.

If a competitor wishes to add themselves to the Event Road Section cover offered via the organisers then they can do so prior to the event, providing they comply with the following: is aged 18 years or over; has held a full motorcycle license for a minimum of 6 months; has no more than 6 points on their driving license; has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years and are named on a valid motor insurance policy for the motorcycle they are riding on the Event; do not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motorcycle policy; the motorcycle has a valid MOT and taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so. There is no cost involved in using the ACU RTA cover.

Any competitor who falls outside these parameters must seek approval from the Appointed Insurance Broker prior to the event. Approval can be sought by sending an email to the (Appointed Broker: Karan.Rochford@lockton.com or Becky.Kendall@lockton.com and provide the Riders' name and date of birth, the date they passed their full motorcycle test and details of any motoring claims and/or convictions.

Additional cover provided by this scheme is only effective whilst the motorcycle is actively competing in the event and remains under the control or direction of the event organiser(s).

Cover will cease immediately if you are precluded from starting, excluded or retire from the event.

The Event Road Section scheme is provided by ABC Insurance Brokers Limited and underwritten by First Underwriting Limited.

INSURANCE: Cars

It is the individual competitor's responsibility to ensure that they are properly insured as required by the Road Traffic Act for the public road sections of the event. The club have arranged insurance with REIS to enable car competitors whose everyday policy excludes trials, competition etc. to comply with the Road Traffic Act for the public road sections of the event. The premium for those car entrants wishing to take up cover for the trial will be £25.00. Competitors who are able to comply with all of the following: over 19 and held a full licence for at least 6 months; has no more than 6 points on their licence; has had no more than 1 fault claim in the last 3 years is named on a valid motor insurance policy for the vehicle they are driving; do not have the Third-Party Extension cover on their existing motor policy; the vehicle has a valid MOT and taxed for the road, unless exempt from doing so, will be accepted automatically. NOTE: Anyone aged less than 19 years old will also be accepted at the same price should their co-driver be a more senior member of their family or over 25. If you are unable to comply with any of these points, you will require a Letter of Acceptance; contact the Secretary of the Trial straight away to arrange this. If you have not received your Letter of Acceptance prior to the date of the event, you will not have cover.

All entrants - I declare that I am medically fit to enter this long distance event and am not receiving treatment or medication that may impair my judgement.

Refunds of 85% will be made for anyone who withdraws before the official entries closing date or if the event is cancelled. No refunds will be given to anyone who withdraws after that date unless they fill a vacant marshalling post.
